Group of Boral sponsored Conservation Volunteers of Australia at the nursery



We're constantly amazed by the range of young people coming to holiday in Australia who offer themselves as volunteers for conservation work. Two such groups were hosted by Envirocare over the past two weeks. First a group of 15 Japanese school girls spent the afternoon potting up seedlings and finding insects in the shade house. Squeals of delight / fear? when they encountered the many "foreign" bugs. A second group of ten young people, through Conservation Volunteers of Australia (CVA), came from diverse backgrounds: England, Netherlands, Italy and Japan. They worked long and

hard for two weeks, through a lot of heavy rain, and planted out nearly 1300 trees to provide future rainforest habitat for the endangered Myola frog and southern cassowary. They also weeded, removed vines, mulched and potted seedlings and almost had dishwasher's hands, scrubbing over 2000 pots with vigour. We'd like to thank these dedicated young people for their commitment to conservation work. Our special thanks also to Boral, who sponsor CVA managed teams. They provide funds for CVA team management, to assist not-for-profit groups such as ours achieve important conservation work.

And extra special thanks to our regular volunteers who have planted over 7,500 trees this year!! A great effort.
