Mobile Muster -Turning old mobiles into forests

Last year Mobile Muster ran a campaign asking people to hand in their old mobiles and accessories and they would donate \$2 a kg for a tree to be planted through Landcare Australia. Kuranda Envirocare was lucky enough to be chosen as one of four groups in Australia to receive this funding and we'll be using it to extend rainforest habitat for endangered species, such as the Myola frog and Southern cassowary. We'll keep you posted on progress. Watch for community plantings next year.

Help us plant 500 trees, sponsored by individuals through our Envirocare GROW Project. We're restoring the margins of the forest on Warril Creek to provide more rainforest habitat for the endangered Myola frog and palm.

Bring a hat and water, gloves and a trowel if you have them. All holes will be dug and fertilised, so you just need to plant and mulch. We'll do the rest.

Then return to the nursery for a session on soil erosion with Joe Rhodes, followed by morning tea and a cold composting demonstration. After a cuppa we'll take a short stroll through a couple of sites near the nursery - one 3 years old, and the other one year old. Come along to all or part of the morning.
