TREE OF THE WEEK.

Shefflera Bractescens (Pascoe Umbrella) \$2 each

Distribution and Ecology - Restricted to the Iron Range and McIlwraith Range areas. Altitudinal range from near sea level to 600 m. This species can grow as a normal tree but frequently grows as an epiphyte in rain forest or as a lithophyte on sparsely vegetated granite boulders. Also occurs in New Guinea.
